**Re. School Visits at King Edward VI Northfield School for Girls**

I am writing to let you know that we intend to continue school visits and experiences from September 2021 at King Edward VI Northfield School for Girls. We will continue the format that was introduced successfully in 2019, to run two trip days for the whole school, so that every pupil gains a set of valuable learning experiences outside the classroom as part of their education. These visits will be provided free of charge to all pupils.

Pupils will attend these visits or experiences on 23<sup>rd</sup> September 2021 and 2<sup>nd</sup> March 2022. This means each pupil will have two per year across the five years at TGGs. These visits will be as follows:

<b>Year Group</b>	<b>23<sup>rd</sup> September</b>	<b>2<sup>nd</sup> March</b>
Year 7	A sports coaching day.	A trip to Warwick Castle.
Year 8	A visit to Oxford to visit some of the museums.	A trip to Think Tank (including the Planetarium) at Millennium Point.
Year 9	A visit to Croome Park for an outdoor walk and activities around the estate.	Visits to colleges and universities.
Year 10	A trip to the London sights.	Visits to colleges and universities <b>Or</b> Walsall Art Gallery (art students).
Year 11	A trip to Nottingham to visit the National Justice Museum. <b>Or</b> Carding Mill Valley (Geography students).	Theatre (in school) <b>Or</b> Liverpool Art Gallery (art students).

A small number of visits that are part of GCSE courses will still take place in Year 10 and 11 on other days of the year as well, as well as a number of visits linked to extra-curricular activities and careers education. Teachers leading these visits will advise parents/carers of these via ParentMail in advance.

We also anticipate a number of residential visits restarting in 2021-22, including Activity Residentials open to Years 7,8 and 9, the French Residential and perhaps a History Visit to Belgium and Germany. Further information on these optional residentials will come in due course via ParentMail.
