I write with a number of updates:

## 1) Bus Strikes

The indefinite strike action affecting bus transport is having an impact on a number of pupils and families. All teachers have updated the work available on TEAMs for any pupil affected. In addition, <u>the Oak National Academy lessons are well worth allocating time on</u>.

Whilst the main buses which service this area are not currently running, it is worth monitoring the <u>company website</u> for any changes.

We have considered whether we can arrange our own mini-bus service but the geographical spread of the children impacted means this is not feasible. We continue to look at this solution and we will be in contact with the relevant families if this changes. Heads of Year may also be in contact with some families to discuss possible solutions. I apologise for the tardiness of communication around this.

## 2) Year 11 Boosters

All subjects offer after-school boosters to Year 11 pupils with your child's class teacher. These sessions are invaluable in providing specialist small group support and opportunities to address specific areas of weakness in the run up to the GCSE exams. I urge you to discuss with your child which boosters they currently attend and encourage further participation. Boosters vary in times, but generally run from 3.15 - 4.00pm nightly.
