Dear Parent / Guardian

I write with a number of reminders and updates from the school.

- Both the Open Evening and Open Morning were a great success. Prospective parents were extremely complimentary about the school, the staff, the pupils and the calm and positive atmosphere. I would like to thank all pupils who came back into school either as guides or to help out in departments. All pupils were a real credit to the school.
- 2. We are very excited to be potentially launching our first ever Ski trip. The trip will take place in the half term of February 2025 and we are inviting the pupils currently in Years 7, 8 and 9. Pupils will be receiving information via assemblies next week and interested pupils will be bringing a letter home outlining the key details. At the moment we are just gauging interest. If we have enough interested pupils we will proceed with this trip.
- 3. Year 11 will have another set of mock examinations starting on Monday 13th November. A lot of pupils have already started to take advantage of the after-school revision sessions. The revision sessions that pupils can attend are:

- 6. Parents of pupils in Years 7 10 will have received an email regarding the National Tutoring Programme. If you would like your child to attend the tutoring sessions please go to this link on <u>MS</u> <u>Forms</u> and complete the questions by Wednesday 27th September. A short deadline date is in place due to the overwhelming popularity last academic year. Please be aware the places will be allocated on a first come first served basis.
