Dear Parent / Guardian,

I write with a number of updates:

1) Year 11 Revision Guides

In order to further support Year 11 pupils in their independent revision at home we have provided your child with a full set of revision guides last Monday. Each pupil was given a total of 8 books for them to use at home for the revision period, each guide is the student's own responsibility.

These books are not expected to be paid for as the school has purchased them (at quite a financial cost) BUT, we do expect your child to look after them. All revision guides will be expected to be returned on a "clearance day" after the exams- we will let them know this date in due course. We do hope that providing a revision guide for each subject will not only help you in the financial cost of supporting your child during the exam period but also help support exam success by enabling pupils to have the correct resources to revise at home.

Any work you can do with your child in ensuring they have both the directed time and appropriate study space to make maximum use of these fantastic resources will be really helpful for your child in the challenging weeks ahead.

2) School Review
