Mrs Campbell – SENDCO - Full time

Appointed in June 2022 Mrs Campbell is a qualified SENDCO who has completed the NASENCO qualification as well as an MA Education in Special Educational Needs and Inclusion. She has extensive experience of overseeing SEND provision in both mainstream and specialist settings.

Miss Brown – Assistant SENDCO (Monday, Tuesday & Thursday)

Appointed in April 2022. Miss Brown is an experienced SEND administrator with extensive experience supporting complex students in lessons and interventions. She has experience of supporting children in care and overseeing and creating evidence to support Access Arrangements.

Mrs Collins – Level 3 Teaching Assistant – Literacy support

Mrs Collins works closely with the English and maths department, identifying and supporting students with low literacy levels. She is also a key adult to a number of students with an EHCP and delivers reading interventions during morning registration.

Mrs Croft –Level 3 Teaching Assistant – English as an Additional Language

Mrs Croft is a bi-lingual, TeFL experienced Teaching Assistant who supports students who speak English as an additional language. She is responsible for in class support and 1-2-1 direct intervention for those students new to English. Mrs Croft is a trained Thinking Reading practitioner and also supports the Lexia reading intervention.

Miss Harvey – Level 3 Teaching Assistant – SEMH, Autism, Medical Needs

Miss Harvey has immense experience of supporting students with lifelong medical conditions such as diabetes and Cystic Fibrosis. She also has experience of supporting students who have a physical disability. Miss Harvey works closely with students needing support with their mental health and can provide in class support, daily check ins and where appropriate, 1-2-1 mentoring sessions to help students develop strategies to manage their anxiety. Miss Harvey is a trained Thinking Reading practitioner and also supports the Lexia reading intervention.

Ms Neath – Level 3 Teaching Assistant – Medical Needs & Homework Club

Ms Neath provides in class support across a range of subjects. She works hard to support students who might need help understanding curriculum content and teacher instructions and also runs the school's homework club every day. Ms Neath also has experience of working with students with a variety of different medical needs.

Miss O'Grady – Level 3 Teaching Assistant – Cognition and Learning in class support

Mrs O'Grady is a Level 3 Teaching Assistant with extensive experience of supporting students with Downs Syndrome. She also has experience of supporting students with a physical disability and has received training in order to support with the delivery of the student's physiotherapy programmes. Miss O'Grady can deliver Entry Level qualifications in English, Maths, Science and some technology qualifications. She is trained in precision teaching and has experience of delivering the reading and spelling programme to support those students with low literacy levels. Miss O'Grady is a trained Thinking Reading Practitioner and also supports the Lexia reading intervention.

Mrs Clarke – Level 3 Teaching Assistant – Cognition & Learning in class support

Mrs Clarke is Level 3 Autism trained Teaching Assistant with extensive experience of offering 1-2-1 support to students with high levels of anxiety. She also supports students with Down Syndrome and delivers intervention to support progress. Mrs Clarke also has experience of supporting students with a physical disability. Mrs Clarke is a trained Thinking Reading practitioner and also supports the Lexia

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reading intervention.

Miss Groves – Level 5 Higher Level Teaching Assistant – 1-2-1 and in class support

Miss Groves is a Level 5 HLTA with extensive experience working in primary schools, specialising in phonics delivery and support. She is a Thinking Reading practitioner and TR Lead and is key adult for a number of students with EHCPs across both key stages. Miss Groves is also a mental health and well-being lead.
