Submitting your application

- ◆ You will receive an email confirmation once you have submitted your application form. Please check this to make sure everything is correct.
- ◆ You can amend your preferences right up to 11.59pm on the closing date.

Accepting the place offered

- ◆ The offer letter will explain how to accept or refuse the offer that has been made.
- ◆ You are strongly encouraged to accept the offer, so your child has a guaranteed place for September 2025.
- ◆ If you do not want the offer that has been offered you need to contact admissions by 16th March 2025.

- ◆ Apply on time. If you apply late, you are less likely to get offered a place at any of your preferred schools.
- ◆ Read the admission arrangements for the secondary schools you are interested in to see how likely it is that your child will be offered a place there.
- ◆ Think in advance about transport arrangements for your child.
- ◆ How close you live to a school is very important. Schools have cut-off distances which change each year based on demand.
